On behalf of the City of Madison, I am pleased to submit the City's FY10 appropriations priority request for the reconstruction of the intersection of highways M & S. The City is requesting federal funding to offset the high cost of real estate acquisition.

The CTH S (Mineral Point Road) and CTH M (Junction Road) project is a critical Madison initiative.
